DOG CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (4)

- 1) **CHADWICK BEST SELLER** (Eckersley) Five-month-old, small, balanced, well marked blenheim, pleasing head & pigment, short coupled, excellent bone & conformation, first class presentation, cooperated perfectly with his handler both standing and on the move.

BEST PUPPY DOG IN SHOW.

- 2) **LOWILANI RED LABEL** (Brokopp) Larger Blenheim, eight-month-old. Lovely head, soft expression. Well made throughout. Lighter coat colour than #1 with plenty of coat and furnishings.
- 3) **NIGHTINGALE HEART OF GOLD** (Mulligan) Well marked blenheim with lozenge. Neat body shape. Not as mature in head or body as the 2 puppies who placed above him. Good coat colour. Moved steadily.
- 4) **CARLEN MYRDDIN WYLIT AT TYCWN** (Knauss/Close) Eight-month-old Black & Tan. Bright tans, good coat colour & texture. Dark eyes & pretty head. Not as compact in shape as the other puppies. Moved better going away than coming back.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (2)

- 1) **DREAMVALE NOT THAT KIND OF ANGEL** (Sage/Colbert) Small blenheim of nice size & very pleasing sound conformation, moved well with plenty of drive.
- 2) **AUTUMNHILL IN MY WILDEST DREAMS** (Parente) Blenheim of nice size & attractive head, good ear placing & knew how to use them, pleasing body & conformation. Just a little naughty, would not show himself off either on the move or standing. A pity.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1) **FORESTCREEK KEEGAN** (Whitmire/Cline) Fourteen month old blenheim with lots of style, lovely head, large expressive eyes with excellent pigment; good reach of neck & straight front, well bodied with a good turn of stifle and sound constructed hindquarters, moved with plenty of drive keeping a super topline & tailset, presented beautifully.
- 2) **CHADWICK ONE WAY TICKET** (Eckersley) Blenheim larger in size than #1. Pleasing head, well constructed body & conformation, plenty of coat and furnishings. He moved really well keeping a good topline. Needs a little more weight.
- 3) **SARANADE ROMANCE IN THE RAIN AT TYCWN** (Knauss) Heavier marked tri colour with lots of style, lovely head, large expressive eyes with excellent pigment; good reach of neck & straight front, well bodied. Showed himself off well, wagging nonstop.

NOVICE DOG (1)

- 1) **RIVERVIEW TICKET TO RIDE** (Paplauckas) Mature, two-year-old heavier marked boy, pleasing head, good deep chest & ribcage with a good tailset, very sound hindquarters, moved so well with lots of style.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (2)

- 1) **CH CHADWICK BEST DRESSED** (Robinson) Glamour and style in abundance, pleasing generous head and darkest of eyes, melting expression. Well ribbed, level body, richly marked, good neck and shoulders, sound moving with exceptional drive behind maintaining a good flowing outline throughout.

RESERVE WINNERS DOG. BEST BLENHEIM DOG IN SHOW. BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW.

- 2) **BARRINGTON'S PATRICK** (Robinson) Blenheim with gentle expression, well constructed body with good neck and shoulders, nicely marked very sound movement.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (3)

- 1) **FIELDSEGE RIDING SHOTGUN** (Slusher/Slusher) Blenheim. Very nice overall appearance with masculine head. Well set ears, dark round large eyes. Black nose Medium neck fitting well. Sound front and rear quarters. Proportioned body, well broken coat markings coat. Moving well.
- 2) **LEGENDCREST FINICKYSKYE DREAM CATCHER, JW** (Utych/Utych) Mature well coated blenheim, lovely head & pigment, beautiful eyes, very well presented, correctly marked, good hindquarters. Sound mover.

- 3) **NIGHTINGALE GOLD RUSH** (Mulligan) One year old, heavily marked, richly coloured Blenheim youngster, coat & feathering coming. Pretty head & attractive eyes - just needs finish to his coat.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (3)

- 1) **ALMEARA I BELIEVE, JW** (Parente) Quality headed blenheim with beautiful eyes, full of himself, covers the ground well, very clean markings, lovely coat & feathering.
- 2) **JAYBA JEAN PIERRE, JW** (Lander/Lander-Hamilton) Very showy blenheim, loved his head and large dark eyes. Correct size, good bone, lovely make and shape. Moved so well both ways.
- 3) **BLUEDAY MICH E LOB AT CHEWCREEK, JW** (DePhillip) Blenheim not as mature as #1 or #2, gentle expressive head with large dark eyes, neat shape with strong hindquarters. Moved true both ways.

HEALTH AND CONFORMATION DOG (1)

- 1) **CH KHATIBI ONE IN VERMILION, ENG JW** (Maddox) Attractive ruby, correct head with soft expression with good neck and shoulders keeping a level topline, correct tail set and carriage good bone and well turned of stifle, showed steadily.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (2)

- 1) **BLUEDAY MR WONDERFUL** (Gross/Gross) Lovely soft expression. elegant shape and make. keeping a level topline with good movement. A lovely silky coat completes the picture.
- 2) **ROSEHILL LEEDSINGER, CA**, (Dingman) Another handsome blenheim, A little larger in size with a well developed sturdy body, excellent substance of bone, level topline and correct tailset. Carrying a abundance of silky coat.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR DOG (2)

- 1) **BELLA SOGNI DOLCI DE AMOR** (Weeks) A lovely headed Tri boy with rich tan markings, broken coat pattern, large dark eye, good pigment, well placed shoulders, good reach of neck and well angulated hind quarters. Sound mover.
- 2) **CHEWCREEK FERNANDO** (DePhillip) Pretty headed dog with a lovely large dark eye, good pigment, rich tan markings, good reach of neck, short compact body with a good spring of rib. A heavily marked boy who moved with purpose.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

- 1) **JEWELCROFT EMBEE REMY MARTIN** (Calabrese/Sands/Squirrel)
Lovely headed ruby, good eye & expression. Balanced throughout showing good strong movement. Rich coat colour with plenty of feathering.

BEST RUBY DOG IN SHOW.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN DOG (3)

- 1) **AUTUMNHILL SILVER JUBILEE** (Woodward/Parente) Beautifully presented boy, soft attentive expression. In excellent coat with bright tans in all the right places. Very sound movement and had a lovely profile which he held throughout.

BEST BLACK AND TAN DOG IN SHOW.

- 2) **DREAMVALE TIME WARP** (Perini/Sage/Colbert) Very sound mover both ways, well shaped head, correct eye. good pigment, good lay of shoulder, level topline, firm body in good coat which needed some attention.
- 3) **CORBONA'S FIREHEART OF NOONVALE** (Bertron) Larger in size boy who has large dark eyes, correct shape head, good pigment, well laid shoulders, covered body, well presented straight coat.

OPEN DOG (5)

- 1) **CH CHADWICK CODE BLACK OF CEILIMOR** (McCarty/Eckersley)
Gorgeous Tri, the epitome of toy spaniel, very good head, softest of expressions, good reach of neck & lay of shoulder, just enough spring of rib for his short coupled body. Moved soundly & with drive, showed his little heart out, Gleaming well broken coat. loved him.

WINNERS DOG, BEST AMERICAN BRED, BEST TRI IN SHOW.

- 2) **CH FOXWYN COOL WATER** (Norton/Baker-Fox) Beautiful looking blenheim full of breed type, in super coat, lovely head, large dark eyes, soft gentle expression. Moved soundly front & behind & showed well.
- 3) **CH BROOKHAVEN THE DREAM LIVES ON AT FINNICKYSKYE** (Utych/Utych) Blenheim in good coat & lovely condition, nice type of head, good neck & shoulders, level topline, tail carried correctly, moved & showed well.
- 4) **CH CHADWICK JET SETTER AT HUDSONVIEW, JW** (Glynn/Glynn) Correct head, soft expression, nice dark eyes. He also makes a very pleasing outline with his good conformation. Very well presented.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (2)

- 1) **CH CLARMARIAN CLASSIC BY DESIGN** (Young-May) Blenheim of lovely type & quality, good skull with large, dark eyes, most pleasing

expression, excellent body & muscletone, moved soundly with drive, lovely silky coat.

- 2) **STELLAR ROMANCING THE STONE AT TYCWN** (Knauss/Rose) Lovely quality sound tri colour, masculine head, nice large & dark eyes, excellent ears, moderate neck, good ribs & body, well let down in stifles, sound hocks, good tail, nice coat & feathers, good mover.

BITCH CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (8)

- 1) **BLUE GARDEN LA DOLCE VITA** (Matos/Glynn) Nine months old pretty headed blenheim with lozenge. Lovely dark round eyes. Good use of well placed ears. Neat body shape. Moved well.
- 2) **BLUEGARDEN FINAL EDITION** (Matos/Glynn) Another very pretty blenheim, liked her size, sweet head and lovely expression, good topline free sound mover.
- 3) **TUDOROSE FORESTCREEK BRISTOL** (Mixon/Cline) Happy soul, lovely head and expression, nicely balanced with good angulation both ends, well held topline, sound and enthusiastic on the move.
- 4) **HIGHCLERE FIRST COMES LOVE** (Dingman) Blenheim girl who was a little longer cast than those above her. Good body, excellent coat and colour, sound mover.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

- 1) **TUDORR ADA** (Degen/Degen/Mixon) Lovely 10 months blenheim, who caught my eye as soon as she came in the ring. She has a beautiful generous head framed by high set and well feathered ears for her age, and large dark eyes giving that melting softness of expression that is so essentially "Cavalier". Good reach of neck into well angulated forehead and matching quarters, just right for spring of rib, level topline held on the move, well set tail, she used herself to advantage on the move, free sound and effortless. Overall a puppy who excels in breed type and balance.

BEST IN SHOW, WINNERS BITCH, BEST PUPPY IN SHOW, BEST PUPPY BITCH, BEST AMERICAN BRED BITCH IN SHOW, BEST BLENHEIM BITCH IN SHOW

- 2) **BLUEDAY HERE COMES THE SUN** (Gross/Gross) Another promising blenheim youngster, correct bite, good nose pigment, nice dark round eyes, good length of neck, correct length of rib & loin, another one who moved nicely.
- 3) **SHERAH A STAR IS BORN** (Crommett) Another sweet blenheim, who I'm sure will do well for her owner, very pretty with huge dark eyes with a

wicked sparkle about them, lovely size and shape. Good bone for her size, excellent spring of rib and level topline.

- 4) **BROOKHAVEN AZURO'S STAR AT MADRYN** (Weeks) Nice head shape. Attractively marked. Having a lighter marked coat over a shapely body. Moved well.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (4)

- 1) **BLUEGARDEN ITSY BITSY** (Matos/Glynn) Beautiful example with lovely eyes and good head qualities. Very pretty. Well-broken coat covering a well-made body. Moved and showed to perfection.
- 2) **TINTAGEL DE LOS URSIDOS KODIAK** (Williams/Williams/Echazarra) Tri. Very pretty. Medium size. heavier marked, good head type, shapely body starting with a good neck and finishing with a good tail carriage. Moved and showed well.

BEST TRI BITCH IN SHOW.

- 3) **ALMEARA ONCE SMITTEN TWICE LOVED, JW** (Whitmire) Blenheim. Smaller type with such a mouth-watering head. Textbook. Beautiful eyes. Soft expression. Lighter marked and in lovely coat. Not so true on the move.
- 4) **NIGHTINGALE OVER THE TOP, JW** (Mulligan) Blenheim. Very pretty with lovely eyes and good head qualities. Richly marked coat covering a well-made body. Stood and showed well. Moved ok.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

- 1) **AZALEA RUN YOU'RE A FINE GIRL** (Taylor/Parente) Seven month old mature bodied black and tan. Pretty head, type, although a little overweight moved well.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (1)

- 1) **CH BROOKHAVEN FORBIDDEN FRUIT, JW** (Ayers/Martz) Blenheim, lovely character, correct for type, pleasing in head & kind expression, lovely type all through. Plenty of well prepared coat and furnishings. Very free moving.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (2)

- 1) **LINRICA MIRACLE BABY, JW** (Liu) Blenheim, feminine, full of type & balanced all through. Pleasing outline, good coat & colours, furnishings in good order.

- 2) **BENTWOOD CAROUSEL OF LIVELYOAK** (Borton/Harrison)
Blenheim who has a feminine head, well cushioned, with sweet expression, moved out well & kept her shape, outgoing temperament. Just delightful.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (2)

- 1) **LINRICA REACH FOR THE STARS, JW** (Liu) Richly coloured blenheim, well broken. Beautifully presented. Very pretty, good pigment with large round dark eyes. Really liked her size and shape. Moved with style and drive around the ring.
- 2) **CHADWICK TATTLETELLER TALES** (Eckersley) Another blenheim girl of lighter coat colour, she has a very pretty head with really good large dark eyes, she showed steadily. Just preferred the coat colour of #1 and her finish.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH (2)

- 1) **CHADWICK PURPLE PASSION** (Eckersley) Beautiful headed tri colour, so correct with the most gorgeous eyes, good shape & moved very well, good neck & shoulders & well sprung rib, coat in good condition.
- 2) **CLOPSVILLE MYSTIC** (Rychlik) Tri colour, another with prettiest of heads with large dark eyes, well cushioned foreface, yet unexaggerated, good rich tan, in gleaming condition.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (4)

- 1) **AUTUMNHILL HONKY TONK ANGEL** (Parente) Ruby with very pretty head, lovely dark, round eyes & sweet expression, good mouth & pigment, liked her shape in profile with good rib & short coupled, in between coats at the moment but not much to hide & should do well when back in condition, looked good in profile going round.

BEST RUBY BITCH IN SHOW.

- 2) **FIELDSEGE THREE HOUR TOUR** (Slusher) A soundly constructed ruby who was mature and in good coat, Good balance and bone and free flowing movement. She has a lovely head with large dark eyes, dark pigment and gentle expression.
- 3) **MADRYN PORT ROYAL** (Weeks/Weeks) Pretty ruby of good make and shape, with large dark eyes, black pigment and presented in gleaming coat.
- 4) **INFINIDAD PYROMANIA** (Laliberte/Laliberte) Ruby bitch who had large dark round eyes, flat skull, long ear leathers and was nicely put together. Presented in good condition and she moved well keeping a level topline.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN BITCH (5)

- 1) **BROOKHAVEN MAGIC MOLLY** (Martz/Ayers) Mature black and tan bitch in full coat with almost flat skull, dark eyes, black pigment and gentle expression. A happy showgirl who was well constructed and moved well.

BEST BLACK AND TAN BITCH IN SHOW.

- 2) **DARANE JANE EYRE** (Hossler/Kates) I liked the make and shape of this black and tan bitch who had large dark round eyes, flat skull, long ear leathers and was nicely put together. Presented in good condition and she moved well keeping a level topline.
- 3) **CHIYODA BLACK PEARL OF JOY AT FALLING SPRINGS, JW** (Curley) Pretty black and tan girl with a soft expression, good neck and shoulders, she had large dark round eyes and black pigment and moved with drive. She has a silky texture to the coat.
- 4) **HYTEA PUDDLE JUMP OF CHARDOMONT** (Comer/Greak) Black and tan who has beautiful dark eyes & pleasing balance to head giving typical expression. Good rich colour & pleasing outline. Moved very well.

OPEN BITCH (4)

- 1) **CH FORESTCREEK AMBLESIDE FLEUR DE LIS AT MIMRIC, JW** (Hodges/Cline) Blenheim. Well made although a little larger in size than my ideal, good ribcage & loin, nicely balanced angulation. Very warm expressive eyes, high set ears & good top skull & well proportioned muzzle. Moved extremely well going & coming & showed good reach & drive in profile, with good tail carriage.
- 2) **CH SUNJAYS RUMOR HAS IT** (Hellman) Blenheim, beautiful dark eyes & pleasing balance to head giving typical expression. Good rich colour & pleasing outline. Moved very well going & coming & with a pleasing balanced profile. Good outline with nice neck & tailset.
- 3) **CH CARLEN CHATEAU STE MICHELLE, JW** (Close) Lovely soft expressive eyes, well feathered ears & moderate stop. Well built body with good ribcage, lovely neck & topline with well set tail. Well proportioned outline & moved very well.
- 4) **BONITOS COMPANEROS XAVERIA, JW** (Lasser) Blenheim. Very pleasing head with shallow stop & large warm eye, flattish top skull & high set ears. Very good in body with moderate rib & short loin & good neck & topline. Moved well.

SENIOR OPEN BITCH (1)

- 1) **BLACKFIRE I APPROVED THIS MESSAGE** (Weidig/Kennedy/McLaughlin) Seven-year-old blenheim, Lovely neck & topline, well put together body with moderate rib & short loin. Sweetest feminine expression with shallow stop, large eyes tapered muzzle, high set ears & good topskull. Moved with excellent head & tail carriage in profile with good reach & drive. Quality well presented coat.

VETERAN DOG (1)

- 1) **CH CLARMARIAN CLASSIC BY DESIGN** (May) Blenheim of lovely type & quality, good skull with large, dark eyes, most pleasing expression, excellent body & muscle tone, moved soundly with drive, lovely silky coat.

VETERAN BITCH (1)

- 1) **SHEEBA DISCOVER BETTY BOOP** (Gross/Gross) This blenheim girl belies her 14 plus years. Glamorous girl with quality well presented coat & furnishings, very level topline with well set tail. Firm build with moderate rib & strong couplings. Lovely dark warm expressive eyes with high set ears, good topskull & tapered muzzle. Very positive on the move covering lots of ground & holding an impressive outline.

BROOD BITCH (1)

- 1) **CARLEN FIRST PICT SANGIOVESE** (Close) Black and tan, large expressive eye, flat top skull, high set ears with good neck & topline. Moved holding herself well with balanced reach & drive.
