DOG CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (7)

- 1) **FALLING SPRINGS RAMBLIN GAMBLIN MAN** (Curley). A beautifully marked Tricolor boy. Small and well balanced. Good rear going away nicely. Rich tan markings. Good reach and drive in profile.
- 2) **ORCHARDHILL AUSPICIOUS AT TUDORROSE** (Mixon/Mixon/Venier/Venier). Bl. Five month old with well broken coloring. Good pigment. Good bone. Nice eyes reflecting an alert expression.
- 3) **BROOKHAVEN CATCHING FIRE** (Ayres/Martz) Ruby. Cutest little boy. Well balanced, small and nearly square. Good bone. Round, dark eyes set well apart.
- 4) **CYRANDELL LAST CRUSADE** (Dingman). Tri. A bit larger boy, but well balanced. Good bone. Side gait showing good reach and drive. Pleasing head and expression.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1) **MILBU UNIQUE CHOICE** (Theodosiadis) Bl. A nice pleasing head with round dark eyes. Good substance. More heavily marked and a bit longer in the loin. Nice easy side gait and moving well going away. **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW.**
- 2) **BROOKHAVEN ALMOST PARADISE** (Ayers/Martz). Bl. A sweet face. Well balanced boy. Good bone. Stifles and hocks well turned. Strong rear movement.
- 3) **CHADWICK CHARISMATIC OF BLUEBONNET.** (Vezina). Bl. Side movement showing good reach and powerful drive. Good bone. High Tail carriage detracts.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1) **CHADWICK PURSUIT OF PERFECTION.** Bl. (Eckersley). A handsome boy with a sweet expression and round dark eyes. A bit long in loin. Good substance. His mother is one of my all-time favorites.

- 2) **GRANASIL GOLDEN DELICIOUS OF SUMARA.** Ruby. (Gentil). Rich coloring. Round, dark eyes and good pigmentation. Nice lay of shoulder and good turns at his rear.
BEST RUBY IN SHOW
- 3) **NIGHTINGALE REVOLUTION.** Bl. (Cameron). I like his size and rich chestnut coloring. Sweet expression. Well balanced. Drops off at the croup.

NOVICE DOG (1)

- 1) **FORESTCREEK LIVIN IN PHILLY.** Bl. (Taub/ Cline). A happy boy with excellent temperament. More heavily marked. A bit up on size. Showing a nice level topline and moving soundly.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (4)

- 1) **BROOKHAVEN JUSTIFIED.** Bl. (Ayers/Martz). A well-balanced boy of correct size and substance. His handsome face highlighted by round, dark eyes. Good coat with rich coloring. Short coupled with a level topline.
- 2) **CHADWICK BEST SELLER II.** Bl. (Eckersley/Reed). A richly colored dog. Handsome headpiece. Well angulated front and rear. Well let down hocks. A bit bigger and longer than number 1.
- 3) **ORCHARDHILL DONE TALKING.** Bl. (Venier/Venier). Beautiful markings head to tail. Great coat and well groomed. Longer in loin. Something of a worried look.
- 4) **DREAMVALE NOT THAT KIND OF ANGEL.** Bl. (Perini/Sage/Colbert). This moderate sized boy has good bone, rich coloring. Cobby. Sound moving. Needs more neck.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (4)

- 1) **NIGHTINGALE WIPEOUT.** Bl. (Mulligan). What a sweet face with large, round dark eyes. Richly colored. Good substance. Movement is good, but in the middle of nice reaching strides, begins to paddle, then back to proper reach.
- 2) **ALMERA SONG SUNG BLUE AT TUDORR.** Bl. (Mixon/Mixon). A Small boned male. Nice ear set and good length of neck. Sweet and happy expression.
- 3) **GRANLAUREL LIVIN ON A PRAYER.** Bl. (Gregory/Green). Nicely broken coloring. Rich chestnut markings. Good bone. Nice length of neck. Moves efficiently.
- 4) **PINNACLEE CHOCOLATE BUTTONS.** Ruby. (Norton). He was a reluctant mover today. He has a handsome face with beautiful eyes.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (8)

- 1) **FOXWYN REVOLUTIONARY.** (Dingman/Baker-Fox). BL This beautiful dog has so much I look for in our Cavaliers. A handsome headpiece, not overdone. His large, round, dark eyes, are set well apart. Nice length of muzzle. Ears set high. Nice length of neck.

Moderately coated with coloring rich and well broken. He shows a level topline with a tail carried level off the back to slightly up and in constant motion. Well angulated front and rear. - 2) **CHADWICK SCUTTLEBUT**. Bl. (Carter). Another very nice boy. A little heavier marked. He moves down and back soundly. His sweet expression and wonderful temperament won me over. [RESERVE WINNERS DOG.](#)
- 3) **CHADWICK MELODRAMA**. Bl. (McCarty/Eckersley). Very richly colored dog. Moderate in size and short coupled. Lost his topline a bit on the go around.
- 4) **LOWILANI RED LABEL, JW**. Bl. (Brokopp). Longer cast boy with a beautiful side gait. Well coated.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (6)

- 1) **ORCHARDHILL NEWS TO ME**. (Venier/Venier). A moderately sized dog. Short coupled and well balanced. He has a handsome headpiece with the big, dark eyes I love. Well broken in color and well angulated. Moderate coat in beautiful condition.
- 2) **BROOKHAVEN IM A BELIEVER, JW**. (Dingham). A bit longer in the loin than number 1. Showing nice movement in profile. Well broken coloring.
- 3) **ORCHARDHILL WHY STOP NOW?** (Venier/Johns). Sound moving dog. Well angulated in front and rear. Abundant coat. Good bone.
- 4) **LEGENDCREST FINNICKYSKYE DREAM CATCHER, JW**. MP. (Utych). Beautiful coat, straight, moderate and well broken color. Good bone. Moves soundly.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR DOG (2)

- 1) **CHADWICK BUGATTI AT HUDSONVIEW**. (Glynn/Glynn/Eckersley). A very nice tricolor with well broken coloring and rich tan markings. Moderately coated. Well angulated front and rear. Short coupled. Good substance. [BEST TRICOLOR IN SHOW](#)
- 2) **SARANADE ROMANCE IN THE RAIN AT TYCWN**. (Knauss). A heavily colored boy with such a sweet expression. Good bone. A bit longer in loin.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN DOG (4)

- 1) **DREAMVALE GENTLEMAN JACK AT FIELDSEDGE**. (Slusher/Slusher/Smith). This boy is a solid, well-built dog. Moving with strong drive and nice reach. Holding a level topline. Coat is well conditioned. A finalist for major points. [BEST BLACK AND TAN IN SHOW.](#)

- 2) **AUTUMNHILL SILVER JUBILEE.** (Parente/Woodard). Rich tan markings and a handsome head. Ears set high with an alert expression.
- 3) **CARLEN MYRDDIN WYLIT AT TYCWN.** (Knauss/Close). Nice coat, rich in color. Nice size and shape. Lost his topline on the go around.
- 4) **CORBONA'S FIREHEART OF NOONVALE, C-TKN.** (Bertron). A rather long shaped dog. Carrying his tail well up. Very handsome headpiece.

OPEN DOG (4)

- 1) **CH BROOKHAVEN FOREVER YOUNG.** Bl. (Bolster). A well marked boy with a straight coat, moderate in length. Well put together with good bone and nice angulation, front and rear. He has a sweet face but rather small eyes.
- 2) **CH BROOKHAVEN THE DREAM LIVES ON AT FINNICKYSKYE.** Bl. (Utych). A dog of correct size. Short coupled. Coat in nice condition and well broken in coloring. Good rear angulation. Moved soundly.
- 3) **ORCHARDHILL ARISTOCAT.** Bl. (Venier/Venier). A beautiful dog with a masculine yet sweet face and soft expression. His round dark eyes add to the soft expression. Movement is sound. Coat is abundant and well-conditioned.
- 4) **CH ROYALMARK REMINISCENCE.** Bl. (Cameron). I like this boy's size and shape. He has a sweet look and expressive face. Very heavily marked with rich chestnut coloring. Topline did not hold level on the go around.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (2)

- 1) **STELLAR ROMANCING THE STONE AT TYCWN.** B/T. (Knauss/Rose). A handsome boy with round, dark eyes. Rich tan markings. Moves very strongly for his age.
- 2) **CH BELLA SOGNI DOLCI DE AMOR.** Tri. (Weeks/Weeks). A Well-broken tricolor with rich tan markings. A sweet expression. Good Substance. Nice side gait showing a level topline.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (3)

- 1) **LIVELY OAK BENTWOOD CORA SUNDROP.** Bl. (Harrison). This is a sweet little girl face with large, round, dark eyes. A nice length of neck. Side gait shows a level topline, good reach and drive. Nice layback of shoulder. Well broken markings. ***BEST PUPPY BITCH IN SHOW.***
- 2) **TUDORROSE GIGI.** Bl. (Mixon/Mixon). Pretty, feminine head piece. Rich chestnut coloring. Nice angulation front and rear.
- 3) **BROOKHAVEN BABY LETS DANCE.** Bl. (Ayers). Happy temperament. Colors well broken. Good bone and nice turns at stifle and hock. Good lay back of shoulder.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (1)

- 1) **NIGHTINGALE KOKOMO**. Tri. (Mulligan). A very nice puppy. Pretty face with dark eyes. Moves down and back and around soundly. Short coupled. Nice front and rear angulation.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (2)

- 1) **TUDORR LEMON BREELAND, JW**. Bl. (Mixon/Mixon). She has a pretty head piece with round dark eyes and good pigment. Well broken markings. Nice length of neck and good spring of ribs.
- 2) **FOXWYN AWESOM BLOSSOM**. Bl. (Baker-Fox). This is another pretty girl with rich coloring. Perfect size. She needs to get out and get to practice and have fun. Too serious.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

- 1) **ORCHARDHILL HIGH DRAMA**. Bl. (Venier/Venier). A girl with a beautiful face and the large dark eyes I love. Nicely broken coloring. Good substance.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (4)

- 1) **CH MIMIC THIRTY SIX TWENTY FOUR THIRTY SIX**. Bl. (Hodges/Perkins). This is a beautiful bitch with the lovely head. The eyes that are large, round, dark and set well apart that we need to perpetuate. Rich chestnut red coloring. Solid bone, moderately deep chest and well sprung ribs. Coat in beautiful condition.
- 2) **BROOKHAVEN SEEING IS BELIEVING**. Bl. (Ayres/Martz). Another lovely bitch with a sweet expression. Just a bit longer in loin than the first. Nice length of neck. Good turns at stifles with hocks well let down.
- 3) **FIELDSEGE SUGAR MAGNOLIA**. Bl. (Slusher/Slusher). A strong moving girl. A bit larger than those before. Good bone. Well angulated. Sweet expression.
- 4) **STARMARC SHOW ME**. Tri. (Hooper). A really lovely girl. Heavy markings are a bit deceiving. Good substance. Topline drops off a bit much at the croup. Confidence will help her ring performance.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (6)

- 1) **LEGACY CHENIN BLANC WITH EVERA**. Bl. (True/Maschner) This well-balanced girl moves so soundly. Goes and comes back true. Her side gait is smooth showing good reach and strong drive. She has a good length of neck and a level topline. Tail extends right off the back and in constant motion on the move. Good bone. All this with a good coat, lovely face and round dark eyes. **[WINNERS BITCH AND RESERVE](#)**

- 2) **TUDORR QUIETLY MAKING NOISE AT AMMICK.** Bl. (Mixon/Madden). Lovely head with ears set high. Good length of neck. Topline level standing and moving. Strong rear with good angulation and well let down hocks.
- 3) **BROOKHAVEN SEALED WITH A KISS.** Bl. (Dingman/Ayers/Martz). Just a great show temperament. A solid girl with good bone, well sprung ribs. A lovely face with large, round, dark eyes.
- 4) **CHADWICK PICTURE PERFECT.** Bl. (Eckersly). Such a cute, happy girl-Cavalier temperament. Cobby, solid in build. Good turns at stifles and well let down hocks.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (2)

- 1) **ISLEPOSEA WHISK ME AWAY.** Bl. (Hoehn). She has wonderfully rich color. Ears set high with good feathering. Coat soft and silky. Good substance. Beautiful eyes.
- 2) **KRYSTLE ITS ALL ABOUT AMY.** Bl. (Torgersen/Torgersen). What a sweet expression. She is cobby and has good bone. Light coloring.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (4)

- 1) **ISLEPOSEA WONDERLUST.** (Hoehn). Such a pretty, feminine headpiece with beautiful eyes. Silky straight coat, rich in color. Short coupled. Well Sprung ribs and good bone.
- 2) **ROCKCREEK EXCUSE ME BOYS AT DULCE.** (Covell). A beautiful face with lovely eyes set well apart. Good cushioning. Nice length of neck flowing into well laid back shoulders and a level topline. Love her size and shape. So close to number 1.
- 3) **BLUEGARDEN FINAL EDITION OF CHARDOMONT.** (Greak/Comer). A sound moving girl showing a level topline with tail carried level with her back. Good coat and good bone.
- 4) **TIBBEDON MISTY MORNING, JW.** MP. (Tibbetts). Another lovely headpiece. Good pigment, pretty eyes and nice high ear set. Well conditioned coat and beautiful ears.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH (1)

- 1) **BRYREWOOD YOU SEND ME.** (Torgersen/Baldwin). Nicely broken coloring. Good substance. She has nice turns at the stifles and hocks. A really sweet expression.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (1)

- 1) **GRANASIL FLORENTINE OF SUMMARA JW.** (Gentil). She has rich red coloring. Lovely eyes and good pigment on nose, lips and eye rims. She would not settle in the ring today.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN BITCH (2)

- 1) **CHIYODA BLACK PEARL OF JOY AT FALLING SPRINGS, JW.** (Curley). This girl has a lovely face. Rich tan markings. Good substance. Shoulders well laid back. Shows a level topline in profile. Good turns at stifles and well let down hocks.
- 2) **AUTUMNHILL SUMARA JUST FLIRTING WITH YOU.** (Parente /Gentil). A dainty girl with a nice lay of shoulder and well angulated rear. She has the sweetest face and expression.

OPEN BITCH (2)

- 1) **FIELDSEGE NAMASTE.** Bl. (Slusher/Slusher/Smith). This girl with the wonderful ears set high has a beautiful coat, well groomed. Pretty chestnut coloring, nicely broken. Her movement in profile shows good reach and strong drive and a level topline.
- 2) **CH TUDORR ADA, JW.** Bl. (Mixon/Degen/Degan). A girl with good substance. Abundant coat. A nice length of neck. She is longer in loin than I would prefer.

SENIOR OPEN BITCH (1)

- 1) **CHADWICK STORYTELLER.** Bl. (Eckersley). Nearly eleven years of age, this wonderful girl was solid on the move coming at me and going away. In profile she held a dead level topline. She is short coupled with a good length of neck and beautiful face. So happy and confident in the ring today. **RESERVE WINNERS BITCH, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW AND BEST VETERAN IN SHOW.**
