DOGS

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1) **CHADWICK HOT PURSUIT AT HUDSONVIEW** (Glynn/Glynn)
What a little cracker, just loved everything about this baby boy, head and expression was lovely, size and balance just all fitted together, had good bone, and moved around the ring like he owned it, he also had the temperament to match, exciting youngster who I am sure will take the big spots soon. **BEST PUPPY DOG, BEST PUPPY IN SHOW & RESERVE WINNERS DOG**
- 2) **COBRNIK RED WINE** (Cook)
Ruby who scored in front angulation and neck, pleasing in head and eye with a soft gentle expression, covered the ground well, but would have liked a shorter back.
- 3) **NIGHTHAWK'S HEAVEN CAN WAIT** (Ellenson/Ellenson/Mitchell)
Well-marked pretty headed Blenheim, with large dark eyes, good for size and ample bone, moved well, and presented in good condition.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1) **PARLETT FERNANDO EL MAGNO** (Williams/Williams)
Heavily marked tri who presented a nice outline when standing. Has a pleasing head large dark eyes and soft expression. A lot of tan in the right places, moved well in both directions, with a nice head carriage, coat texture was good and well presented.
- 2) **FALLING SPRINGS JUST YOU WAIT AT CROWNROSE**
(Rosenberg/Rosenberg)
Well-marked blenheim, with a pleasing head and expression, ears set well, good front angulation, kept topline on the move with good tail carriage.
- 3) **LAREINA HERE COMES THE SUN** (Roberts-Espinosa)
Well-marked, a little bigger in size than I like, perfect spot, eyes large dark, happy temperament, just would prefer a size smaller.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (2)

- 1) **COVINGTON NEVER SAY NEVER** (Brock/Gonyo)

Well-marked with a good colour, moved freely with good topline and tail carriage, nice head large dark eyes and good expression, would benefit from a little extra body weight to complete the picture, presented well with a happy temperament.

2) **COBRNIK WALK THE LINE** (Cook/Goodwin)

Tri well marked with good tan colours, would like a better front, and eyes could be a shade darker, moved ok.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR (5)

1) **CH CHADWICK PURSUIT OF PERFECTION JW** (Eckersley)

Blenheim well marked coat of good colour, lovely head and eye, ears set well, expression good, so well made in body and so balanced throughout, with good front and rear angles, covered the ground with ease and presented the outline I was looking for when standing, lovely temperament. **WINNERS DOG, BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR & BEST IN SHOW.**

2) **CH BROOKHAVEN ALMOST PARADISE JW** (Ayers/Martz)

Another nice dog with his title, good for size and balance, well-marked with good colour, head was pleasing with dark nose pigment. Kept his topline on the move with good tail carriage.

3) **ASTARRING ALL THE CATS PAJAMAS** (Foster Flowers)

Heavily marked blenheim, who scored in head and expression, with lovely round dark eyes, shown in good condition and lovely straight silky coat. Would just like him a shade shorter in loin and a little more leg. But lovely type.

4) **CH HARRINTON THE BEAR NECESSITIES** (Marina-Tompkins/Gonyo/Gonyo)

Slightly bigger size blenheim, well-marked coat, masculine head, large dark eyes, sound on the move, just would like a size smaller.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (3)

1) **ORCHARDHILL THEATRE KID AT KINDOMRUN** (Mixon/Degan)

Nice type blenheim with large dark eyes and soft expression], nice for size and balance, with moderate bone, in good coat and condition, just tended to lose his topline on the move. Handled and shown well.

2) **COBRNIK MAXWELL** (Cook)

Black/ tan in nice coat and condition, little longer in back, pleasing in head shape, eyes could be slightly darker, moved well in profile. **BEST BLACK AND TAN IN SHOW**

3) **CROSSBOW BALOO FROM THE JUNGLE AT BLUESTARA** (Glines/Alvarez)

Blanket marked Blenheim, short in back, moderate head with large dark eyes and good pigment. Would like a better front angulation.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (2)

1) **NIGHTHAWK GAME CHANGER** (Crail/Mitchell)

Well-marked blenheim, little longer in back, nice front with good lay of shoulder, and moderate neck. Kept level topline on the move, in good coat, would like a darker eye.

2) **INTRYNZIK SAUVIGNON** (Goodwin/Cook)

Black tan, nice overall size and balance, with good tan markings, moved well in profile, Shown in good coat and condition, would like a darker eye.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (5)

1) NIGHTHAWKS GREAT EXPECTATIONS (Dirks/Mitchell)

Lovely type Blenheim, heavily marked coat of good condition, lots to like about this boy, nice head with large dark eyes soft gentle exp, moved well with good front and rear angles, spirit level topline, just tended to be a bit uneasy with his handler today, but liked him a lot.

2) ALMEARA FORESTCREEK PATRICK (Whitmere/Cline)

Slightly smaller compact Blenheim, full of breed type, heavily marked well-presented coat, pleasing head and expression, moved well both directions.

3) COVINGTON RHAEGAL (Gonyo/Mohn)

Slight bigger type, well-marked, would like a better front angulation, head was pleasing with large dark eyes. Moved well in profile.

4) CROSSBOW SIR CHARLES OF HUBER OF THE VILLE (Huber)

Up to size Blenheim, pleasing head and eye, would like a better front angulation and a size smaller.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRI DOG (4)

1) BROOKHAVEN DON'T STOP BELIEVING (Ogle)

Heavily marked tri, nice head type with gentle expression, large dark eyes, rich tan with plenty of it, good for size and balance, moved freely with good tail carriage.

2) CHADWICK BUGATTI AT HUDSONVIEW (Glynn/Glynn)

Smaller in size than one, well-marked, head a little heavier than I like, with a slightly shorter muzzle, large dark eyes, ears set well. Little heavy over the shoulders. Nice temperament.

3) NOBLE FLAIRE DE LOS URSIDOS KODIAK (Williams/Williams/Gemenez)

More heavily marked tri, lots of tan, slightly plainer in head, with soft exp. Moved ok with good topline. Presented well.

4) LAREINA SPLAIN IT TO ME (Roberts-Espinosa)

Well-marked with rich tan markings, good for size and moderate bone. Would like a softer head and expression, moved ok front and rear.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

1) COBRNIK INTRYNZIK COUNT ROWAN (Hudspeth)

Nice size ruby of pleasing type, pretty in head with soft gentle expression, coat colour good, moved well in profile keeping level topline, nicely presented with a good temperament.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN DOG (1)

1) ROBINS NEST MASQUERADE (Prodanovich/Kaecbling)

B/t with a fairly balanced outline, small compact frame, large dark round eyes, ears set well, little short in muzzle, moved happily with good tail carriage.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

- 1) **STARMARC BLUE LAGOON** (Hooper)
Well-marked tri with plenty of rich tan, liked her overall size and balance. Pretty in head and eye, moved well in both directions keeping a level topline and good tail carriage, presented well. **BEST PUPPY BITCH**
- 2) **CEDAR CREEK ALL ABOUT PRETTY** (Owens)
Blenheim well marked, good for size and bone, pretty in head with large dark eyes and good expression, would like a better neck and shoulder placement. Lovely temperament and presented well.
- 3) **CHADWICK HALO SPOT AT INTRYNSIK** (Goodwin)
Another typey Blenheim with a pretty feminine head, large dark round eyes, ears set well, when standing presented a nice overall shape, just tended to pick up her front action when moving
- 4) **TIALULLY TATOO TOOTSIE AT CARLEN** (Close/Rubno)
B/T nice size with moderate bone, pleasing in head shape, with large dark eyes. Good neck and front, just moving a little close behind.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

- 1) **CHADWICK BACCARAT OF CEILIMOR** (McCarty/Eckersley)
Tri well marked coat with lots of tan in all the right places, nice overall type with a pretty feminine head, round dark eyes, ears set well. Moderate bone, moved freely with good carriage, presented and handled well.
- 2) **CHADWICK ROULETTE** (Eckersley)
Tri litter sister to first place, similar remarks apply, just preferred the head and balance of 1st place.
- 3) **KENDALL KASTLE KEEP THE FAITH** (Ogle)
Nice size fairly balanced in outline, nice rich tan, heavily marked coat., pleasing in head shape, moved well.
- 4) **COBRNIC COAT OF MANY COLOURS** (Hudspeth/Cook)
Heavily marked tri colour, with lots of tan, good topline, nice overall type, would like a better rear angulation and more blaze.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (3)

- 1) **PARLETT LONDON FOG** (Williams/Williams)
Blenheim very happy and showy, fairly well balanced in outline, which showed when moving. good topline and tail carriage. Pleasing in head with large dark eyes, well set ears, honest type of bitch with a lot to like.
- 2) **COBRNIK ALL THE WAY** (Cook/Goodwin)
Lighter marked Blenheim pretty feminine head, large eyes but would like a shade darker, good front with moderate neck. Would like a little shorter in back. presented well.
- 3) **LOCKSTAR'S GOBLET OF FIRE AT MERAKI** (Miller/Lockleer) Smaller B/T, pleasing head shape with large eyes, would like better bone and a little more substance, and a better front angulation.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

- 1) **BENCHMARK UNSINKABLE MOLLY** (Hoorman)

Small dainty little Blenheim, feminine head shape with round dark eyes, soft expression, moved freely, would just like a shade bigger with a better front angulation and more neck and a bit more bone.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (4)

- 1) **BROOKHAVEN MARY JANE** (Ayers/Martz)
Nicely marked Blenheim in good coat, liked her overall size and balance with moderate bone. Pretty in head and expression, with large dark eyes, ears set well, moved freely and happily to win the **RESERVE WINNER BITCH**, presented well.
- 2) **CH INTRYNZIK DANCED ALL NIGHT** (Goodwin)
Ruby of nice overall type, excels in neck, moving with style and elegance, keeping a good topline, pretty in head, just would like a shade shorter in the loin. **BEST RUBY IN SHOW**
- 3) **ROCKCREEK GUCCI GIRL** (Steagal)
Blenheim well marked coat, little plainer in head, but has large dark eyes and a gentle expression. Moved well in both directions.
- 4) **MAGNOLIA RUN LIGHTENING STRIKE** (Guzy)
Blenheim with a pleasing head shape, pretty large dark round eyes. good for size. moving wide in front, nice happy temperament.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (3)

- 1) **CROSSBOW THE RELUCTANT DEBUTANTE** (Schiffman)
Blenheim well marked coat, pretty head and eye, moved well in both directions, just would like a shorter back, nice overall type.
- 2) **SHEEBA AMELIA BEDELIA AT INTRYNZIK** (Goodwin)
Another well marked blenheim, moving and showing well, head shape pleasing, good topline on the move, just lacks a bit of maturity.
- 3) **CHADWICK LACE COLLAR** (Eckersley)
Blenheim with a nicely marked coat, head was feminine but a little short in muzzle, large dark eyes, ears set well, kept a good topline when moving.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (8)

- 1) **NIGHTHAWK GOIN TO CALI** (Morigi/Mitchell)
This heavily marked blenheim headed this class of nice bitches, well made all through, pretty head and soft expression, moved out well with good topline and tail carriage, good overall size and balance to match.
- 2) **HADARA FAITHFUL SOUL AT CLOUDBASE** (Koch/Scanlan-Johnson).
Another lovely bitch, very pretty in head and eye, soft gentle exp, with well-set ears, good neck, moved freely around the ring keeping a good topline, handled and presented well.
- 3) **TUDORR LEMON BREELAND** (Mixon/Mixon)
Slightly stronger in type than 1 & 2, but a very useful type, sound and well made, pleasing in head with large dark expressive eyes.
- 4) **CHIYODA JUST MY CUP OF TEA OF GLENELLEN** (Murphy)

Well-marked blenheim, nice type, little high in rear, and would like a shade shorter back, pretty feminine eye with good eyes.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (3)

- 1) **IVYLINE SHIRLEY TEMPLE AT GYLDEN** (Ellingson/Ellingson/Giampapa)
Well-marked Blenheim with spot, liked her overall size and well-balanced body, which showed on her good movement. Topline was good. Pretty in head with nice round dark eyes. Moved and showed well.
- 2) **ON THE MARK HAPPY ENOUGH** (Chan/Mitchell)
Another well marked Blenheim, nice size with good bone, pleasing in head and eye, ears set well, soft expression, just carrying a bit too much weight around her shoulders. Nice temperament.
- 3) **BEARIVER CALIFORNIA GIRL** (Toepfer)
Larger size blenheim, heavily marked coat, head a little heavy for me, eyes were round but would like a shade darker, and a little long in back.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRI BITCH (2)

- 1) **TRUELEGANCE MOONLIGHT RHAPSODY** (Crome)
Lots to like about this pretty headed heavily marked tri colour, she has the most pretty of head shapes with large round dark eyes, ears set well, and super soft exp. Size is good and so balanced throughout. Moved well in both directions keeping a good topline and tail carriage. Presented in tip top condition, **[WINNERS BITCH, RERSERVE BEST IN SHOW & BEST OPPOSITE SEX TO BIS & BEST TRICOLOR IN SHOW](#)**
- 2) **TINTAGEL DE LOS URSIDOS KODIAK JW** (Williams/Williams/Echazarra)
Bigger framed than 1, and more masculine in head shape, in lots of coat with good tan, moving well, would just like a size smaller.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN BITCH (1)

- 1) **ROBINS NEST AUDREY HEPBURN** (Prodanovich) Pretty headed black tan, with rich tan markings, eyes large but would like a shade darker, moved adequately front and rear, keeping a good topline and tail carriage, would prefer a shorter back.

OPEN BITCH (3)

- 1) **CH HARRINGTON COVINGTON ONCE UPON A TIME AW** (Gonyo/Gonyo)
Heavily marked tri colour with plenty of rich tan, liked her size and balance, pretty in head and eye, moving very well in profile with good topline and proud head carriage, showed and presented well. pulled out for consideration in my cut.
- 2) **CH SORELLA HERE COMES CHLOE JW** (Green)
Very feminine pretty Blenheim, well-marked, nice head with large dark eyes, neat little shape, looks very much a baby just now needs coat and finish, and for me would like a little more bone. But lots to like.
- 3) **CEDAR CREEK JELLY BEAN** (Owens)
Bigger framed blenheim, well-marked, pleasing in head and eye, would like a shorter back, lacking confidence and really not enjoying her showing. Presented well.

VETERAN DOG (1)

- 1) **CAN CH STELLAR ROMANCING THE STONE AT TYCWN** (Knauss/Rose)
Tri colour fairly heavily marked coat, looking good for 10 years plus, masculine head with large dark round eyes and plenty of tan, moving well and enjoying his day.

BEST VETERAN IN SHOW

VETERAN BITCH (1)

- 1) **SHADOWBROOK DELTA DARLING**, CRN,CGC,CGCA. (Moody)
Tri colour, little on the heavy size, pleasing in head shape, ears set well and round dark eyes. Moving happily but needs to tighten up in front movement.
