### Important Information

The Breeder of the litter being posted;

1. Must be current with their CKCSC dues. Breeders of litters being posted after October 31 must have renewed their membership for the next year before the litter can be posted.
2. Must have REGISTERED a litter with the club within the last two years. If they have not, they need to get THIS litter registration to the Registration Chairperson prior to this litter being listed.
3. If a member does not have an affix registered with the CKCSC, USA, then the Club's affix REGIS will be used to list the litter.

#### Note:

If you are not the Breeder of your Cavalier and are trying to find him a new home, you should know that the CKCSC, USA, places expectations on the Club Breeders. Please read the statement below carefully. If you have any problems finding a new home for your Cavalier, please contact the Breeder, if known, before placing the Cavalier into Rescue.

#### Statement of expectations placed on Club Breeders regarding dogs that may come into Rescue

The CKCSC, USA Board of Directors recognizes that Cavaliers bred and sold by Club Members occasionally need re-homing from the families to whom they were originally sold. Doing what is in the best interests of the individual dog is paramount. The CKCSC, USA, Inc. holds every expectation that a Club Member Breeder **will take back any dog they have produced for the lifetime of that dog.** If a breeder is unable to take back and keep or re-home the Cavalier and the dog is placed in rescue, the CKCSC USA, Inc. strongly encourages the breeder to work with rescue to be sure the dog obtains any medical care needed, to provide any information that may be of help in the medical history of the dog, and to compensate rescue for all reasonable veterinary expenses, and other expenses, incurred on behalf of the dog.
