SHOW RULES CHANGE

- 6/27/23 Show Rule II. Dogs – 6: Dogs with one testicle as a result of a medical procedure are allowed to compete.
- 5/16/24 Show Rule I. Owner/Exhibitors - 13: Cavaliers entered in Bred By Exhibitor may be moved to Open if the breeder/owner is unavailable to show the dog. Restrictions apply. Form is required. Other ineligible entries are no longer allowed to move to Open and must be withdrawn.
- 11/23/24 Hotel Rules – Added rule related to supervising children 17 and under.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES CHANGE

- 6/27/23 Rally: Added Rally Choice title effective 10/1/2023.
- 3/4/24 For National Shows only, added Unofficial Veteran Classes by Age using the age categories in Veteran Sweepstakes effective 4/3/24.

IMPORTANT!

Supplemental Entry Form and proof of foreign registration are **required** if you need to enter a dog using its Foreign Registry Number while you are waiting on a CKCSC number. Proof of foreign registration is any document that shows the foreign number is assigned to that dog. The application to register the individual dog or the litter **must have been received by the Registration Office** by late closing or the **entry will not be accepted**. CONFIRMATION DATE IS MONDAY, FEBRUARY 10, 2025!

Entry confirmations will be sent on Monday, February 10, 2025. Please read your confirmation carefully and contact the Show Secretary with any changes immediately upon receipt. If you have not heard from the Show Secretary by this date, contact them immediately.

RINGSIDE READY REMINDER!

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog ringside for all competitions for which they are eligible, including dogs that are eligible to return to the ring for Reserve and Award of Merit competitions. The grooming area and hotel rooms are not ringside. Dogs that are not ringside and ready to enter when called to join the competition may not be allowed to enter the ring (Refer to Show Rules Section I. Rule 21.)

NEW! MAJOR POINTS UPDATE

Schedule of Points has been updated to ensure that a Reserve Win is awarded more points than a Class Win. Additionally, the schedule has been adjusted to reduce the minimum number of dogs or bitches showing to receive the maximum number of Major Points. Refer to the website for the current schedule. (Select Shows and Events – Conformation – Points System.)

INVOICING MAY NOW BE DONE THROUGH QUICKBOOKS

Cavaliers of the Midwest (CMW) will now accept payment through QuickBooks Billing or by Check in the mail.

On the *Summary of Amounts Due* form, add the **\$10 convenience fee, indicating your authorization to CMW to send you an invoice via Quickbooks** and include the amount in TOTAL ALL ITEMS. If paying by Check, send by mail to the Show Secretary.

QuickBooks Billing

1. In the line "Bill Me through QuickBooks", write Yes or No.
2. Beginning the week of **Feb. 3, 2025**, if you wrote Yes and included the convenience fee, you will receive an email from quickbooks@notification.intuit.com with the subject **Invoice from Cavaliers of the Midwest**. The invoice will identify Cavaliers of the Midwest and treasurer Wendy McCulloch. Enter your credit card number and amount into Quickbooks, a secure website. The payment goes directly into the Cavaliers of the Midwest account at US Bank.
3. Your credit card information will be encrypted, and no one will see your credit card information.
4. Do **NOT** submit any credit card information with your entries.
5. DO make sure that the email address on your show entry has the email address to which you wish the QuickBooks invoice to be sent.

SHOW ENTRIES ACCEPTED VIA EMAIL AND US POSTAL MAIL

Cavaliers of the Midwest (CMW) will accept entries via email in addition to postal mail under the following conditions. PLEASE read the instructions CAREFULLY. **Entries will not be accepted until payment is received.** DO NOT SEND ANY CREDIT CARD INFORMATION WITH YOUR ENTRIES.

1. Entries submitted by mail must include either a check or payment is assumed to be via Quickbooks Invoice. Entries postmarked after the postmark closing date are considered late entries subject to the late fee.
2. Entries submitted by email must be received by the postmark closing date. Checks that are mailed must be postmarked by postmark closing.

TO USE THE FILLABLE FORMS

1. DOWNLOAD the CMW Feb. 2025 Summary and Entry Forms from the CKCSC website www.ckcsc.org to your computer. (Current Events – **Feb. 2025 CMW Show**, More Information link.)
2. TYPE all the information required on the form.
3. PRINT the completed forms.
4. SIGN the completed forms. (It is a requirement that all entry forms be signed.)

TO SUBMIT THESE FORMS VIA EMAIL

1. SCAN and SAVE the completed and signed forms to your computer as a single file.
2. EMAIL the file to the Show Secretary at CMWShowSec@gmail.com.
3. If you are paying by check, mail the check by postmark closing date.

| American Bred | Dogs 18 months and older, whelped in the USA of a mating that took place in the USA and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title. |
| Second Generation American Bred | Dogs 5 months and older which are American Bred and of which both sire and dam are American Bred, and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title. (Offered at the National Specialty, Members Club Show, and Trudy Brown Memorial Rally only.) |
| Health & Conformation | Dogs 5 years of age and older with an OFA certificate that shows and OFA registry number and states that the dog has no evidence of hip dysplasia after 2 years of age and is certified clear within 1 year of the postmark closing date for that show of the following diseases: 1) Heart – by a board certified cardiologist; 2) Patellar Luxation – by a licensed veterinarian or via an OFA patella certificate; 3) Eyes – by CERF or by a board certified veterinary ophthalmologist's exam sheet indicating that eyes are "normal". Copies of the 4 certificates must accompany the entry form for any dog entering this class. |
| Special Limit Blenheim | Blenheim dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age. |
| Special Limit Tricolor | Tricolor dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age. |
| Special Limit Ruby | Ruby dogs 5 months and older and not holding a CKCSC, USA championship title if over 12 months of age. |

FINAL AND SPECIAL AWARDS

AWARDS

All official conformation classes are judged for dogs, then bitches. Winners/Reserve Winners/Best Puppy competitions take place after judging concludes for that sex. Initial competition for Special Awards Best American Bred, Bred By Exhibitor, Blenheim, Tricolor, Ruby, and Black-and-Tan In Show is held after Best Puppy for that sex is awarded. Unofficial conformation classes, including Best Veteran In Show, are judged after the competition for Winners/Reserve Winners/Best Puppy Bitch. The remaining Final and Special Awards follow the unofficial conformation classes.

FINAL AWARDS

(Championship points awarded if entry justifies.)

Winners (WD, WB) is awarded from the Class Winners.

Reserve Winners (RWD, RWB) is awarded from the remaining Class Winners and the second place dog to Winners.

Best Puppy (BPD, BPB) is awarded from all undefeated puppies under one year of age after Reserve Winners are awarded.

Best In Show (BIS) is awarded from Winners Dog and Winners Bitch.

Reserved Best In Show (RBIS) is awarded from the Opposite Sex Winners and the Reserve Winners to Best In Show.

Best Puppy In Show (BPIS) is awarded from the winners of Best Puppy Dog and Best Puppy Bitch after Best In Show is awarded.

Award of Merit (AOM) is awarded after Reserve Winners from the remaining Class Winners and next placing dog to Reserve Winners or the first AOM winner. (Up to two AOM's are awarded to each sex at all National shows and every championship show during the Regional Annual General Meeting (AGM) weekend.)

SPECIAL AWARDS

(No championship points awarded.)

Best Veteran In Show is awarded from the winners of the Veteran Classes immediately following the Veteran Class competition.

Best Health and Conformation In Show is awarded from the winners of the Health and Conformation Classes immediately following the Best Black-and-Tan In Show competition.

Special Awards: Awarded from eligible dogs from all of the classes. The definition for the Special Award is the same as the associated class definition. They must include:

- Best American Bred in Show
- Best Bred By Exhibitor In Show
- Best Blenheim In Show
- Best Tricolor In Show
- Best Ruby In Show

1. Where applicable, the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, USA, (CKCSC, USA) "Procedure for Registration and Transfer of Dogs" and "Show Rules" will be followed.
2. CKCSC, USA, Members can show any Cavalier King Charles Spaniel puppy that is registered with or awaiting registration with the CKCSC, USA; has a Performance Event Number (PEN); or is ineligible for registration with the CKCSC, USA. Any non-member is welcome to enter their Cavalier King Charles Spaniel puppy.
3. No puppy may be entered under a Judge by whom it was bred or to whom it currently or has previously belonged, including co-ownerships.
4. No Championship Points shall be earned at Pee Wee Puppy Matches.
5. A single class will be offered for puppies at least three (3) months of age, but not yet five (5) months. Best Pee Wee Puppy will be awarded to the class winner. Puppies of the opposite sex to the winner will compete for Best of Opposite Sex to Best Pee Wee Puppy. Critiques will be written for both winners.
6. Puppies must be current on all age-appropriate vaccinations. This is the owner's responsibility. By entering the competition, the owner acknowledges that the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, USA, Inc., assumes no liability for any illness contracted by the puppy as a result of entering the competition.
7. A puppy may be shown on a collar and leash or harness.
